ARDEX SP1

Primer for ARDEX Silicone

DESCRIPTION

ARDEX SP1 is used for priming absorbent substrates or joints to improve the adhesion of ARDEX silicone sealants. It is ideal for priming joints that will be immersed prior to the application of silicone or for sealing sensitive natural stones to help prevent staining of stone edges.

TO (SUBSTRATES)

For absorbent substrates such as concrete, plaster and natural stone.

SUBSTRATE PREPARATION

Ensure the surface to be primed is clean, free of dust, dirt, oil, grease, curing compounds, release agents and barrier materials.

Ensure surfaces are dry, with no residue or permanent damp. Surfaces must be suitable for any subsequent products being used.

MIXING

No mixing required, shake contents before use.

APPLICATION

Brush ARDEX SP1 to the joint sides achieving complete coverage. For very porous substrates a second coat may be required.

Allow ARDEX SP1 to dry prior to the application of subsequent ARDEX products.

All tools should be cleaned with water immediately after use.

DRYING TIME

Allow approximately 60 minutes for ARDEX SP1 to dry at 23°C and 50% relative humidity.

Substrate and climatic conditions will affect drying times.

COVERAGE

Varies depending on joint depth and porosity of the surface.

PACKAGING

ARDEX SP1 is packed in a metal container - net volume 200mL.

SHELF LIFE

ARDEX SP1 has a shelf life of not less than 12 months when stored in the original unopened packaging, in a dry place at 23°C and 50% relative humidity. Protect from frost.

SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

ARDEX SP1 is highly flammable and is harmful if swallowed. Avoid contact with skin and eyes; in case of contact with the eyes, rinse immediately with plenty of water and seek medical advice; wear suitable gloves and eye protection and keep the product out of the reach of children. If swallowed do not induce vomiting, give a glass of water to rinse mouth then as much water as the patient can drink and seek medical advice.
