DESCRIPTION

Water based adhesive for internal & external multi-purpose use free of hazardous organic solvents, for use with ARDEX Weldtec undertile membranes and ARDEX Butyseal. Can also be used for the installation of Outdoor Grass and Carpet over suitably prepared substrates.

Not for permanent saturated areas or areas subject to water ponding unless covering is a suitable ARDEX waterproofing membrane such as WPM 750 or WPM 1000.

SURFACE PREPARATION

All substrates must comply with:

- WPM 750 Applications: NZBC E3/AS2
- WPM 1000/Butyseal-: NZBC E2/AS1
- Concrete substrates: must be to a specific engineering design meeting the requirements of the New Zealand Building Code, such as concrete construction to NZS 3101
- Floor Covering installation: AS 1884:2021

SUITABLE SUBSTRATES

ARDEX WA 88 is designed to bond onto:

- Hardboard underlay approved to AS 2458
- Carpet Pad Underlay
- Cementitious Underlayment
- Dry concrete where there is less than 75% rH
- Plywood
- Wet Area Plasterboard

Contact ARDEX Technical Services for other substrates including terrazzo, ceramic tiles and metal substrates.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Refer to floor covering manufacturer's instructions when working with floor coverings. Installation shall be in accordance with FloorNZ guidelines - Resilient Flooring taking into account AS 1884:2021 and industry best working practices. When working with ARDEX products, refer to relevant installation instructions for overlayment. Condition adhesive and floor coverings to room temperature 24 hours prior to and 48 hours after installation.

Installation temperature of working area and substrate to be a minimum of 10°C and a maximum of 30°C.

Apply evenly to a suitably prepared substrate using a 3.2 mm V3 trowel. Avoid concentrations of adhesive. Install covering immediately into wet adhesive. Cut, fit and reposition carpet within 60 minutes. Roll the covering in both directions with suitable 60lb roller to ensure 100% adhesive transfer. Stiff carpets should be rerolled after 2 hours.

Full strength developed over 24 - 48 hours. Do not expose to heavy traffic within 48 hours.

In internal applications do not expose to water from cleaning or other source for 48 hours.

SPECIAL INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

For external applications adhesive is water resistant after 5 days. Protect from water for five days after installation. Not required if used with ARDEX WPM 1000 or ARDEX Butyseal.

In areas of cold weather and working with rigid floor coverings conditioning the area to a warmer temperature will aid in installation.

NOTE: Do not reuse container. Dispose of container and adhesive residue in accordance with Local waste disposal regulations. Do not flush adhesive down drains.

SAFETY DATA

Avoid eye and skin contact. If eye contact occurs, flush with water for 15 minutes and call physician. Wash skin thoroughly with soap and water. Use with positive fresh air cross-ventilation.
